- 5- List and briefly describe 2 additional characters from the movie. /4
- 6- List 3 facts described in the film that impressed you and explain how each fact relates to science. /6
- 7- Movies can enrich viewers in several important ways. Describe an aspect of the film that showed you something you hadn't seen before, caused you to think in a new way, or helped you understand something more thoroughly than before. /2
- 8- Was there anything that you saw or heard in the film that was unconvincing or which seemed out of place? /2
- 9- Is science treated fairly, or twisted to suit the film-maker's purpose. /2
- 10- What advice about life, message or theme can you get from this movie? /2
